

Dear Suzuki families,

10/27/2022

Please read carefully the Covid-19 safety guidelines that we are requiring all families to follow. Each teacher may add additional guidelines for their individual studios, but the following are requirements for all families and instructors.

1. A well-fitting mask will be worn indoors at all times regardless of vaccination status.
2. Everyone entering the building must either show proof of vaccination, if eligible, or provide a negative Covid test result received within the last 24 hours. This requirement is for students, parents, and guardians, and applies to all events associated with our school (individual lessons, group lessons, rehearsals, recitals). All SIS Teachers are fully vaccinated and boosted and we encourage anyone who has not received their COVID-19 booster to do so.
3. You must stay home and have a virtual lesson if the student and/or their accompanying parent/guardian is contagious (even if it's not Covid). If you are unsure you are contagious, contact your primary care doctor and please exercise caution if considering an in-person lesson. Our teachers reserve the right to send a student home or schedule a virtual lesson if they deem it appropriate for health reasons.
4. You must provide a negative covid test result before coming to your lesson if anyone in your household has been exposed to someone with Covid.

If there is a Covid case within a studio, teachers will email families immediately to let them know, and will switch all lessons to virtual until the instructor receives a negative Covid test result. All instructors are vaccinated and will also be abiding by these guidelines, so they reserve the right to change any in person lesson to a virtual one for any reason. There will be no makeup or reschedule if your in-person lesson ends up being online. Teachers are required to send families home if they show up in violation of any of these guidelines.

If you have a specific circumstance and are unsure if you should attend in person or not, please email your teacher. The King County Public Health office has great information on when to get tested and when to quarantine.

The safety and health of everyone in the school is of the highest importance, and we appreciate you all working together to create a learning environment that is comfortable for everyone.

Thank you for your understanding and your help in keeping our school healthy and safe!
